– Has scored 10 or more runs three times – all against Maine District 3 (10-8 win in 2004, 17-12 in 2007, and 11-3 in 2008)

– In 2007, defeated eventual World Series champion Cartersville, Ga., 5-4

- One-hit Maine District 3 representative Bangor in the 2009 series opener, but lost 1-0
- Played in the longest World Series game in terms of innings and time in Bangor, losing 6-3 in 12 innings to U.S. West on Aug. 18, 2009. The game lasted 3:01.

- Longest losing streak was two, in spanning the semifinal of 2003 and the first game of 2004; and the last two games of the 2005 series
- 2007 representative Falcon, Venezuela, was the first team to go undefeated in a Bangor World Series, winning all six of its games
- Has scored 20 or more runs four times in 31 Bangor World Series games
- Has scored 10 or more runs 11 times
- Has won eight games via the 10-run rule
- Has shut out opposing teams seven times and been shut out three times itself
- Holds the record for most runs in a game, 28, in 2006 against U.S. Central (Madison, Wis.)
- Record in one-run games is 7-6
- Of the region's 11 losses in Bangor, six have been by one run

- The 2006 Paraguana L.L. (Falcon, Venezuela) and 2008 North Cumberland L.L. (Upper Deerfield, N.J.) teams are the only teams to go undefeated in a Bangor World Series.
- Cartersville L.L., Cartersville, Ga., is the only team to lose its first two pool games and then reach the championship game. Cartersville is also the only team to lose its first two games of the series and win the championship, achieving both feats in 2007.
- The longest game in terms of innings was on Aug. 18, 2009, when Fremont, Calif., needed 12 innings to defeat Cornwall L.L., Cornwall, Ontario, Canada. This was also the longest game in Bangor World Series history, lasting three hours, one minute.
- Bangor East/West L.L.'s Jordan Clarke is the only player to pitch a complete game no-hitter. He did it on Aug. 13, 2006, against Regina National L.L., Regina, Saskatchewan, winning 3-0.
- The only player to hit the flag pole in center field with a fly ball was Freehold Township, N.J.'s Ryan Cuneo. It hit below the blue line. Cuneo got a double.
- The only players to have a multiple home run game are Alejandro Diaz (Central L.L., Agana, Guam), who hit two on Aug. 16, 2005, against Habersham L.L., Clarkesville, Ga., and Michael Resnick (West University L.L., Houston, Texas), who hit two on Aug. 18, 2009, against Aruba South L.L., San Nicolas, Aruba.
- Pearl City L.L., Oahu, Hawaii, and Paraguana L.L., Falcon, Venezuela, are the only two leagues to play in consecutive championship games. Pearl City lost in 2005 and 2006. Paraguana won in 2006 and lost in 2007.
- No league has won more than one championship.
- No Maine District 3 team has won more than one game in a series.
- Aside from the Maine District 3 champion, Freehold Township L.L. (Freehold Township, N.J.), Pabao L.L. (Willemstad, Curacao), Pearl City L.L. (Oahu, Hawaii), Whalley L.L. - The highest scoring championship game was in 2003, when Hilo L.L., Hilo, Hawaii, defeated Central Chesterfield L.L., Chesterfield, Va., 16-8.
- The largest margin of victory in a championship game was nine runs, in 2004 when Freehold Township L.L., Freehold Township, N.J., defeated El Rio L.L., Oxnard, Calif., 10-1; and in 2007 when Cartersville L.L., Cartersville, Ga., defeated Paraguana L.L., Falcon, Venezuela., 9-0.
