– Has had 10 games ended early because of being on the losing end of the 10-run rule

– Has been shutout three times: twice in 2002 and once in 2003

– Has given up 20 or more runs three times and 10 or more runs 12 times

– Surrendered 10 or more runs in seven straight games, from 2002 into 2003

– Lost three straight games via the 10-run rule in 2002 and five out of seven games from 2002 through first part of 2003

– In 2007, defeated eventual World Series champion Cartersville, Ga., 5-4

– Canada was no-hit by Maine District 3 in the first game of the 2006 series.

– Canada's longest losing streak is seven games, as the region lost in the 2008 semifinals, went 0-4 in the 2009 series, and has lost its first two games of the 2010 series.

– Has lost four games via the 10-run rule: 12-2 (5 innings) to U.S. South in 2004, 10-0 (6 innings) to U.S. South in 2007, 11-1 (6 innings) to U.S. South in 2009, and 10-0 (5 innings) to U.S. East in 2010.

– Has scored 10 or more runs four times.

– Has allowed 10 or more runs six times.

– Has been shutout six times.

– Beat U.S. West for the first time in 2008. The win snapped U.S. West's six-year streak of reaching the semifinals.

– Tough luck losers in the 2009 series, going 0-4, with one-run losses to Maine District 3 and Asia-Pacific, and a three-run, 12-inning loss to U.S. West.

- The 2006 Paraguana L.L. (Falcon, Venezuela) and 2008 North Cumberland L.L. (Upper Deerfield, N.J.) teams are the only teams to go undefeated in a Bangor World Series.
- Cartersville L.L., Cartersville, Ga., is the only team to lose its first two pool games and then reach the championship game. Cartersville is also the only team to lose its first two games of the series and win the championship, achieving both feats in 2007.
- Bangor East/West L.L.'s Jordan Clarke is the only player to pitch a complete game no-hitter. He did it on Aug. 13, 2006, against Regina National L.L., Regina, Saskatchewan, winning 3-0.
- The only player to hit the flag pole in center field with a fly ball was Freehold Township, N.J.'s Ryan Cuneo. It hit below the blue line. Cuneo got a double.
- The only players to have a multiple home run game were Alejandro Diaz (Asia-Pacific: Agana L.L., Agana, Guam), who hit two on Aug. 16, 2005, against Georgia, and Michael Resnick (U.S. Southwest: West University L.L., Houston, Texas), who hit two on Aug. 18, 2009.
- Pearl City L.L., Oahu, Hawaii, and Paraguana L.L., Falcon, Venezuela, are the only two leagues to play in consecutive championship games. Pearl City lost in 2005 and 2006. Paraguana won in 2006 and lost in 2007.
